Baseboard on a Nosing

How baseboard should terminate where it meets a stair nosing.

X Don't



The baseboard runs long and the nosing pokes out past its end - you are left with a raw, exposed nosing end at the wall.

✓ Do



Baseboard and nosing finish flush at the same point. Clean line, no exposed end, nothing to catch the eye.

THE DETAIL

Where a baseboard lands on a stair nosing, hold the base and the nosing to the same stopping point so they die into the wall together. Cut once, check the line, then nail.
